Next to the Corn Exchange Theatre in Wallingford, St Mary-le-More has a much broader tower than its neighbour St Leonard.

Benson bells were refurbished ~2 years ago, and are now clockwise & easy-going.

The simplest way to Ewelme church is to turn right off B4009 onto Firebrass Hill which leads into Cat Lane, then left onto Parsons Lane in the village. Later follow Parsons Lane the opposite way into the High Street; The Shepherd's Hut is located at the extreme west end of High St, with its car park on the opposite side of Eyres Lane. Its menu often changes; it has a website, www.shepherdshut.co.uk; as their food is all fresh, they would prefer us to phone our orders in the morning (01491-836636).

Berrick Salome church and the Chequers pub (a lunch alternative) are in the east end of the village.
